



## **Terms and Conditions**

### **APPLICATION/PITCHING PROCESS**

- The participant should be between 18-35 years of age to participate in the Northern Adelaide Entrepreneur Scholarship.
- Applicants must live in the council areas of Playford, Salisbury, Tea Tree Gully, Port Adelaide Enfield, Gawler, Adelaide Plains, Barossa and Light.
- Applicants must have a business or business idea that can be viably be based at the Stretton Centre's co-working space.
- Incomplete registrations will not be considered.
- The Stretton Centre is not responsible for any files submitted as part of the application not working/opening.
- Any pitches with the use of sexual, drug related or inappropriate behaviour will not be accepted.
- By applying for the NAES, the applicant agrees to accept any decisions made by the judging panel including the selection of the winners of the competition.
- The judging panel is comprised of mentors from the Business SA SAYES Program. The Stretton Centre is not liable for the reuse of any ideas pitched to the judging panel.

### **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

- Participants are to pitch an idea of their own and not replicate someone else's.
- All applications will be shared with Stretton Centre employees, mentors, judges and sponsors

- All pitches will be videoed, the Stretton Centre reserves the right to publish, modify, and reproduce this footage.

- Any conflict/claim from another entity on the IP, will be the applicant's responsibility. The Stretton Centre does not accept liability for any claims.
